### **SECTION 2: Instructions for Applicant**

The military member, or dependent will not be subject to taking a knowledge test or skills test as if he/she had completed a class offered by the Georgia Motorcycle Safety Program and/or recognized private sites.

Military members and dependents will be eligible to obtain an electronic 90 day license waiver by submitting scans or legible photographs of the following documents to the Motorcycle Safety Program via email to [mspinfo@ms.dds.ga.gov](mailto:mspinfo@ms.dds.ga.gov)

- This COMPLETED application
- A copy of your Motorcycle Safety Foundation Basic Rider Course or Basic Rider Course 2 completion card
- A copy of your current Georgia driver's license or equivalent out of state driver's license
- A copy of your current duty orders and/or a copy of your DD214

Once the documentation has been verified, an electronic 90 day license waiver will be issued to the military member/dependent. Within ten (10) business days, the 90 day license waiver will be emailed. After receiving the waiver, the military member/dependent must visit their local Department of Driver Services Customer Service Center within 90 days to obtain a Class M license.

Military members or dependents that are not currently located in the State of Georgia may apply the military license waiver to their driver's license by completing a mail-in renewal. More information can be found here: <https://dds.georgia.gov/mail-renewals>
